SUBJECT **Dallas Fire-Rescue Ambulance Media Inquiry**

Dallas Fire-Rescue (DFR) recently received a media inquiry from a local news station regarding the status of air conditioning units located in the back of some ambulances.

Three units have been identified, and subsequently placed out of service after temperatures in their rear compartments registered elevated temperatures. DFR is currently working with the vehicle and equipment manufacturers to determine the exact cause of the problem so the appropriate corrective measures can be applied.
